**Contact Tracing** – As you may have heard through the media, contract tracing in schools is changing from this Monday. Following examination of data by public health, the HSE have advised that it is no longer necessary for children in school settings to be included as part of Covid 19 contract tracing. As a result children will no longer be asked to stay home from school when there is a positive case in their class/pod. All Covid 19 mitigation measures continue to be implemented in our school as set out in our response plan (ventilation measures, distance between pods, enhanced school cleaning measures, hand sanitising, cleaning/quarantine of resources between use, class bubbles for yard time, isolation of children with suspected symptoms, staffroom social distancing and adult mask wearing etc). **Please continue to be vigilant for symptoms of Covid 19 and do not send children to school if you have any concerns.
